MOTION TO APPOINT LEGAL PARKING FOR MOTOR HOME

A good faith attempt was made me to verify the validity of this verbal order by seeking confirmation from of the legal backing or order from the City of Dallas Attorney's office where Legal Assistant, Lisa T. Penney told me that an attorney will not confirm or deny the validity of this verbal order because it would be construed as legal advice which is not provided. Then a visit to the headquarters of the City of Dallas police station by me where I presented my parking problem to on duty police officers whom I talked to have confirmed that it was a valid order that I needed to obey.
